Thank you for your request for official information emailed to NZ Health Partnerships (NZHP) on 23 May 2017. You have requested answers to the following questions which we respond as follows:

- 1. How much did the 5.5% price increase last year cost the six participating district health boards in dollars for the 15 year period of the contract, broken down annually and by DHB?**

NZHP responded to you regarding this question on 21 June 2017.

- 2. How much is the 3.5 per cent price increase due on the 1 July 2017 going to cost participating DHBs if no other DHBs sign up to the contract, broken down annually and total cost over the 15 year contract period?**

- 3. Which DHBs by name are still considering the Compass food contract?**


NZHP has decided to withhold the requested information under section 9(2b)(ii) and 9(2j) of the Official Information Act 1982, namely: (a) withholding of the requested information is necessary as making it available would likely unreasonably prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied it or who is the subject of the information; and (b) the withholding of the information requested is necessary to enable the holder of the information to carry on, without prejudice or disadvantage, negotiations (including commercial and industrial negotiations).
