NZ Health Partnerships, in consultation with its shareholders, discontinued Health Benefits Limited's linen and laundry programme in late-2015. Using key materials from the programme, such as a rationalised linen catalogue, district health boards (DHBs) are making ongoing savings locally and regionally.

In 2015, each DHB contributed its share of population-based funding (PBF) for the development costs of the linen and laundry business case.
